BOURTON PARISH COUNCIL LAWN CEMETERY

The graveyard is only available for use by current residents of Bourton or longstanding ex-residents (who have previously lived in the village for at least 10 years). The graveyard is not open to non-residents. It is not possible to buy plots in advance or choose the plot location in the graveyard.

The graveyard is not consecrated ground and therefore residents of any religion (or none) may be buried there. Individual grave sites can be consecrated during burial services.

Grave plots will be flat and grassed over to facilitate the easy upkeep of the graveyard and therefore, although headstones (not exceeding 3 ft in height) will be permitted along with a vase or memorial (not exceeding 1 ft 6 ins) kerbstone edging and memorial slabs will not be permitted.
