






Follow the tracks

NOTES

- Just over 7 miles on tracks, quiet lanes and footpaths (with road alternatives) and an option to reduce to 5 miles.
- Burford. Free car park by the river behind the church. Busy, hence the relatively early arrival to get spaces. Car sharing highly recommended.
- Pass the site of the Bond bell foundry and works en route to Asthall. I can tell you more about Bond's work, but not here...
- Walking a section of the Palladian Way
- The Swan at Swinbrook needs booking for eating
- Swinbrook has connections with the Mitford sisters.
- Leave via the churchyard West gate or preferably the track to the South with its interesting "star" pebble patterns
- Look out for Swinbrook's interesting "inside-out" tower.
- Widford accessible only by path in the middle of a former medieval village
